ANNOUNCEMENT

FULL-TIME FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC ELIGIBILITY TEST

The South Elgin & Countryside Fire Protection District will be conducting testing to create a successive full-time firefighter eligibility list. The District has exhausted its current list that was expected to expire in June of 2023. The District offered full-time positions to each candidate on the list and we hired a number of high quality candidates off that list. We have since exhausted that list and still have immediate openings to fill within our organization.

The District will utilize the National Testing Network's (NTN) online platform to conduct this test. Information regarding NTN and the online testing process can be found [here](#). Prospective candidates must challenge and pass the NTN written test and submit a full-time employment application with the Fire District. Full-time applications can be obtained by visiting the South Elgin & Countryside Fire Protection District Headquarters Station #21 at 1090 W. Spring Street in South Elgin or by visiting the District's website by clicking [here](#). Candidates must complete both steps in order to be an applicant and be considered for an interview if they obtain a passing written score.

The NTN testing window will open on Monday September 26th, 2022. All applications must be turned in and testing complete by October 20th at 1400 hours. Prospective candidates must have an OSFM Basic Operations Firefighter or Firefighter II certification, IDPH Emergency Medical Technician-Basic or Paramedic license and a valid CPAT (with ladder climb) licensure to apply. A paramedic license is required at time of hire.
